

School Banking News - School Banking starts 12th Wednesday

School Banking occurs every Wednesday. Bank books are collected by the teacher at 9am in the class room, and placed in a satchel. The money is counted by a wonderful group of volunteer parents, the books are then returned via your class teacher, generally the same day.

If you are not already a banker - school banking accounts can be opened at any Commonwealth Bank branch or online by a parent with CommBank.

Online: Visit commbank.com.au/schoolbanking and clink in the link to open the Youthsaver account.

In Branch: Visit any branch and ask to open a Youthsaver account for School Banking. Remember to take in identification for you and your child (such as driver's license and birth certificate). At branch you will receive a Dollarmites wallet and deposit book on the spot and be able to start banking on the next business day; online it will be posted to you – it is that easy!

At school: An account opening day will be held with a Commonwealth Bank School Banking Specialist at school on Wednesday 19th February, 8:20-9am. It will be held outside the kinder/prep area.

If your child already has a Commonwealth Bank Account number, no need to complete a registration form, just lets us know their bank account number and we will register them.
